EBYF Parent Code of Conduct

We, the East Brady Youth Football Organization, have implemented the following Sports Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents should read and understand this code, indicating such by initialing the registration form prior to their children participating in our program.

Any parent or player guilty of improper conduct at any game or practice will be asked to leave the sports facility and be suspended from the following game. Repeat violations may cause a multiple game suspension or the season forfeiture of the privilege of attending all games.

Preamble:

The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and teaching six core principles:

- trustworthiness
- respect
- responsibility
- fairness
- caring and compassion
- good citizenship

The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these six pillars of character.

Therefore, I agree:

1. I will not force my child to participate in sports.
2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for the youth, not the adults.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others involved.
4. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the team and league.
5. My guests and I will be positive role models for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials & spectators at every game and practice.
6. My guests and I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or

parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profanity.

7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of the athletes.

8. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect.

9. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning.

10. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard.

11. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or any other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.

12. I will emphasize the importance of skill development and practice.

13. I will promote emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of my personal desire that I may have for my child to win.

14. I will respect the coaches and officials and their authority without questioning, discussing or confronting them at the game field and will address any concerns at an agreed upon time and place.

15. I will refrain from coaching my child and other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the appointed coaches or assistants of the team.

16. As a parent volunteer and/or coach – I will show up when I am scheduled and assigned to perform duties on behalf of the team.

17. If my child has an obligation that will prevent their game day or practice day involvement, I will immediately notify my child's head coach.

18. We will strive to leave all facilities where we participate in the same or better condition than we found them – including abiding by all posted rules and regulations.

19. In the event that we have an issue that needs to be discussed, we will refrain from using social media as the venue for that discussion. We will, instead, take our concerns directly to a board member or the coach. This is the only venue in which issues will be addressed by the EBYF organization. Nothing on social media will be addressed by any member of the EBYF Board or coaching staff for resolution.
